Dear Parent or guardian,

The **Louisiana Boys Adventure Academy is rapidly approaching**. The purpose of the Academy is to provide adventure opportunities for boys and assist your son with completing exciting skills, knowledge, and spiritual growth. Our desire is to provide a week of both fun and accomplishment.

The **medical record form must** be accurately completed and sent to the camp with the registration application in case of an emergency. Please instruct your son that any **medications** he brings must be **left at the First Aid Station at registration Monday morning** and picked up at departure.

There **will NOT be a public phone available for campers to make calls home, send postcards with postage** for writing home. Cell phones should only be used for emergencies. In case of an emergency you may call the camp office at (318) 442-8485. Please allow time to contact your son since he may not be close to the office when you call.

Adventure Academy is the **best value for summer camp I know**. Academy provides swimming classes a \$50 - \$75 value; Red Cross First Aid training a \$35-\$50 value; Leadership Initiative Ropes course a \$200 value; Rappelling instruction a \$275 value; Wilderness Survival camp a \$200 value, Basic Rescue Techniques a \$250 value... The list goes on and on. All of these specialized classes and schools come free with the Adventure Academy. Add to all of this the spiritual impact that will last a lifetime - We can not place a price on this!!!!

Camps and Corps **T-shirt sizes must be selected on the registration forms**. These forms should be sent to the District office by **June 1** so you will not be charged a **late registration fee**. We need time to place orders for hats and shirts. A limited number of extra **T-shirts** will be for sale during the Academy. **PLEASE INDICATE SIZE!!** Also, **indicate hat size**. We recommend that you order extra shirts for a clean change during the week or send Royal Rangers logo shirts for alternates.

**The supply list** for your son's camp is available. We are asking the church to make a copy available to you to use so you will know what your son will need to make his stay at camp more enjoyable. Forms are available online at: [www.larr.org](http://www.larr.org). Look under the Academy or Registration forms heading on the home page. **MARK ALL PERSONAL ITEMS with a permanent marker pen.**

**Arrive before 10:00 Monday morning**. Orientation lunch begins at 11:30; it takes several hours to check in. Any Ranger staying on the grounds and eating meals **prior to Monday Lunch** must pay an **extra \$10.00 per night and \$5.00 per meal**. The campground will not be **open for general arrivals until after 1:00 pm Sunday afternoon**. Rangers in Elite Corps or Special Forces Corps **may arrive Sunday after 1:00 p.m.** without extra meal/lodging charges.

**Departure from the grounds will be 11:00 a.m. Friday**. Everyone should be off the grounds by 12:00 p.m. There will be a **closing ceremony at 10:30**. **Please check into the registration office at the administration building upon arrival to drop off or pick up your boys.**
